## Recommended Size

Generally speaking, a square size no smaller than $3^{\prime \prime}$ and no larger than $5^{\prime \prime}$ is recommended.
If you happen to have a rectangle within these dimensions, this is also acceptable since both squares and rectangles are 90-degree shapes.
