While our first class focused on a round shape, a very forgiving shape, students will now learn how to ensure their square *is square*. Shawn will be sharing her special tip for corners, which can be tricky, including how to mitre a corner effectively

Each program year, we plan to offer the next logical shape for finishing based on the skills taught in the previous year. Possibilities for future programs include a flatfold, which is a square or rectangular shape utilizing a book-binding technique, as well as the heart shape.

Generally speaking, a square size no smaller than 3" and no larger than 5" is recommended.

If you happen to have a rectangle within these dimensions, this is also acceptable since both squares and rectangles are 90-degree shapes.
